The following is an important update to the James and Esther King Biomedical Research Program Call for Grant Applications: New Investigator Research (NIR) Grant for Diseases Related to Tobacco Use, Fiscal Year 2010-2011.

The following text is hereby added to the end of **Chapter 1, Introduction**:

If there are funds remaining after consideration (for funding) of the original pool of applications, the Program reserves the right to move highly meritorious applications submitted in response to Bankhead-Coley Cancer Research Program Calls for Applications to the James and Esther King Biomedical Research Program for funding consideration. These projects must have a prima facie link to tobacco-related cancers. Similarly, the Program reserves the right to move highly meritorious applications submitted in response to James and Esther King Biomedical Research Program Calls for Applications to the Bankhead-Coley Cancer Research Program for funding consideration. These projects must have a clear link to cancer. Applications will only be moved if it is in the best interests of both Programs to do so, and if such action would increase the likelihood of funding for eligible applications submitted for the same grant mechanism. This action shall only apply to the Research Project Grants (RPGs), New Investigator Research (NIR) Grants, and Postdoctoral Research Fellowships (PRFs), and will NOT have any effect on eligibility or application evaluation.
